# SCRIPTURE MEMORY PASSAGES

## ROMANS 5:20-6:2

<sup>20</sup>Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: <sup>21</sup>That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord. <sup>1</sup>What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? <sup>2</sup>God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

#### ROMANS 6:3-5

<sup>3</sup>Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into His death?

<sup>4</sup>Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. <sup>5</sup>For if we have been planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection:

#### ROMANS 6:6-11

<sup>6</sup>Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. <sup>7</sup>For he that is dead is freed from sin. <sup>8</sup>Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him: <sup>9</sup>Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over Him. <sup>10</sup>For in that He died, He died unto sin once: but in that He liveth, He liveth unto God. <sup>11</sup>Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

### ROMANS 6:12-14

<sup>12</sup>Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. <sup>13</sup>Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. <sup>14</sup>For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

## Romans 6:15-17

<sup>15</sup>What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid. <sup>16</sup>Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? <sup>17</sup>But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

## Romans 6:18-19

<sup>18</sup>Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness. <sup>19</sup>I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.

## Romans 6:20-21

<sup>20</sup>For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. <sup>21</sup>What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death.

#### ROMANS 6:22-23

<sup>22</sup>But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. <sup>23</sup>For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

#### Rules:

- 2. Passages are not cumulative.
- 3. 100 point bonus when everyone in the cabin (including the counselor) recites one passage.
- 4. 100 point bonus for each camper who recites ALL the passages.
